PURPOSE

The Alpha Zeta Chapter of ALPHA PI CHI (AΠX) Sorority Scholarship Fund was established in 1963 by the founding members of Alpha ZetaAΠX. The purpose of the fund is to provide scholarships to public high school graduates who have a record of sound achievement in their studies and who demonstrate good school citizenship. The scholarship is an incentive for young adults who show leadership qualities within and beyond their peer group and who have taken initiative in school and/or the broader civic life of the community.



Alpha Zeta Chapter of ALPHA PI CHI will make available two one-time scholarships in the amount of \$1000.00 to a qualified candidate who will attend an accredited, two and/or four year college or university. If the scholarship is awarded to one individual, the scholarship will be distributed once per semester/quarter not to exceed the amount of \$500.00 each term and not to exceed two semesters/quarters. In the event there is more than one equally qualified candidate, the scholarship may be divided among the recipients and given in a one-time installment.

The scholarship is to be used toward the following in order of priority: tuition and fees; room and board; books and supplies and commuting expenses. The recipients are selected by a Selection and Review Committee.

CRITERIA

In making its decision, the Selection and Review Committee will use the following criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 2.5 or above
- Community Service: civic, religious, school organizations and/or activities
- Leadership ability
- · Acceptance of the recipient by an accredited college or university
- Financial need
- Minority group member

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Checks will be mailed to each recipient's home and will be made payable to the student and the accredited institution of choice. The recipients are responsible for delivering the check(s) to the institution.

In order for the recipient who is awarded the entire \$1000.00 scholarship to maintain the scholarship, he or she must continue to demonstrate his or her scholastic achievement by earning a minimum of 2.5 or above grade point average (GPA) each semester/quarter. The recipient must also demonstrate good character. At the end of each semester/quarter, the recipient will provide the Alpha Zeta Chapter of AIIX Sorority with an official transcript and proof of full time enrollment for the next semester/quarter. The subsequent scholarship check will be issued only upon receipt of these materials.

Should a recipient fail to meet the criteria in a given semester, the scholarship will be terminated. If the recipient has serious reason, he or she may make a written appeal to the Program and Education Committee for reconsideration.

SELECTION AND REVIEW OF CANDIDATES

The members of Alpha Zeta Chapter of Alpha Pi Chi Sorority will select the recipient(s) of the Alpha Zeta Chapter of Alpha Pi Chi Sorority Scholarship Fund in April of each year. All applicants will be notified of the results by May of the same year. The scholarship will be presented at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet of the receiving candidate's high school if possible.

Each applicant must submit an application online to the Selection and Review Committee by **April 18, 2024**. The following items should be completed:

- A online application form
- A 300 word essay stating why you should be the recipient of the Alpha Pi Chi Scholarship (online application)
- A recent photo (email to apcalphazetageorgia@gmail.com) with name and high school
- A list of leadership positions in school and community organizations (online application)
