Scholarship Application



The Carroll County HBCU Alumni Association (CCHBCUAA) Scholarships are awarded annually to graduating seniors from a high school within Carroll County who will attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU). **Application deadline is March 31st.**

Eligibility Requirements:

- Graduating senior from a high school located within Carroll County
- Have a minimum 3.3 grade point average (G.P.A.)
- Accepted and will attend a Historically Black College or University

Students who DO NOT meet the above G.P.A. requirement, may be eligible for available Grant funds, but must complete an application.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application
- Current school transcript
- Three letters of recommendation (**one must be from a school teacher/administrator and one must be from a member of the community**)
- A type-written essay of 500 words or more expressing their goals and aspirations and explaining the benefits of attending a HBCU and why they desire to attend.

The CCHBCUAA will award one to four scholarships annually, ranging from \$300 to \$500 based on number of recipients and available funds.
